

# PROFESSIONAL 2012 beauty

## Make-up Competition

The annual *Professional Beauty Make-Up Competition 2012* will be hosted in conjunction with the Professional Beauty Exhibition held at Gallagher Convention Centre on the **2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> September 2012**.

The **Make-up Competition** being in its fifth year will run alongside the Nail Competition on both days of the exhibition. There are categories available for all make-up artists to enter into and put their skills and abilities to the test.

### The Categories

#### 2<sup>nd</sup> September

- ✧ **Glamour Make-up:** Phantom of the Opera
  - Student category
  - Professional category

#### 3<sup>rd</sup> September

- ✧ **Fantasy Make-up:** Super Heroes
  - Students Category
  - Professional category
- ✧ **Body Painting category:** Monsters & Aliens
  - Students Category only

Below are all the Rules and Regulations for the various categories, please read them carefully as you will be expected to adhere to them strictly.

### General Rules for All Make-up Categories

1. Competitors will not be allowed to compete unless they have paid the entry fee in full.
2. Models and competitors must be **over the age of 18** and must be dressed in a professional manner.
3. Competitors must provide all their own materials, bins, make-up, brushes, sponges' equipment, and items required to do the necessary work and achieve the desired look.
4. No mobile phones, no Smoking, food or drink (except water) will be allowed into the competition area.
5. Only competitors, their models and judges will be allowed in the competition arena while the competition is in progress
6. Props may be used to display the model and compliment the theme but must not hinder the model's movement and should not detract from the overall design; 5 minutes will be given to pose the model once the time is up.
7. Pre-judging criteria will count towards the final score and will apply to Competitors in all three make-up categories according to; set-up, neatness, hygiene & sanitation

- procedures professionalism, overall presentation, Health & Safety and working techniques throughout the competition.
8. The completed models will be expected to display the competitors work in front of the judges until they are completely done with the scoring.
  9. Models are not allowed to assist the competitors and mirrors will be allowed.
  10. Scores will be awarded for the overall effectiveness of the make-up, ensuring that it pertains to the theme which has been pre-chosen.
  11. The models hair nails outfit and special attention to detail and presentation of the final make-up will all be taken into consideration.
  12. Competitors and models are expected to stay until the prize giving is over, if they are not present the next highest score will be awarded first place.
  13. **NOTE:** Awards times are subject to change at the discretion of the organizers.
  14. The models make-up and costume may not be removed without the judges' prior permission.
  15. Please make a note of the scheduled competition/prize-giving and finish time.
  16. Photography of models during the competition will NOT be allowed. Only official **Professional Beauty** photographers and media sponsors will be allowed to take photographs, and reserves the right to use these within any publications and for future promotions.
  17. Judges decision will be final and no exceptions will be made for any reason whatsoever. Any discrepancies must be dealt with in a professional manner.
  18. Competitors and models are expected to conduct themselves in a professional manner at all times. Professional Beauty reserves the right to disqualify anyone for misconduct or unprofessional behaviour.
  19. Winners of the previous year in a particular category will not be able to enter the same category. The competitor may either enter another category or alternatively step down for at least one year.
  20. Once time is up you have to place down your equipment and stop working. Should you finish before the time is up you must make sure that you notify a floor judge so that your time is noted on your score sheets.

## Pre Judging Rules & Criteria

*A pre-judging will be conducted prior to and during the competition, the criteria below will be taken into strict consideration and will count towards your final score and applies to all categories.*

- ☞ **Hygiene and Sanitation** Table layout and set-up will be taken into account. Hygiene and sanitation procedures will be taken into consideration, hand sanitizers and other sanitation products must be visible and be used. Neatness and cleanliness will also be a contributing factor. A bin must be provided for disposables. No plastic bags!
  - ☞ **Appearance and dress code:** All artists must be dressed professionally in uniform with hair tied back.
  - ☞ **Safety:** All safety procedures and standards must be adhered to throughout the competition.
  - ☞ **Make- up Mediums, brushes & Products** must be stored correctly and in their original packaging, and properly and professionally labelled. Before the start of the competition, the floor judges will check all tables for products not allowed in the competition.
  - ☞ **Professionalism & Conduct:** Contestants and models must behave in a professional manner throughout the competition. Should your model need to leave the competition area, she will need to be escorted by a competition official; your time will not be able to be made up.
- Model** – Your most important item for the competition is to make sure you have a reliable model, who will be there for you the entire day so make her aware, that she is required for the entire duration of the competition. **NB:** *Models with contagious skin conditions will under no circumstances be allowed to participate.*

## 2<sup>nd</sup> September

### Glamour Category

***This category is to depict the absolute beauty of glamour make-up and should be complimentary to the theme and chosen character.***

✂ **Student** - Competitors have 3 hours to complete the make-up.

✂ **Professional** - Competitors have 2 ½ hours to complete the make-up.

#### Rules & regulations

**Theme:** Phantom of the Opera

1. This category will take place on the 2<sup>nd</sup> of September
2. Pre-judging criteria will apply for this category as for all other categories.
3. Contestants must adhere to the pre-chosen theme, which has been set above and must be depicted throughout the entire look.
4. Make-up is to be applied to the face and neck only and must be complimentary to the model and theme.
5. Hair/wigs can be pre-set by the competitor – prior to the start of the competition. No further work may be done until the competition has started, final styles and hairdo's must be completed on the competition floor.
6. Nail Enhancements may be applied prior but must be decorated or polished during the competition time.
7. If false lashes are used they should be applied during the competition time.
8. No Prosthetics, wax, mastic glue and templates will be allowed for this category.
9. Accessories such as contact lenses, jewellery etc may be used but should be kept to a minimum and be complimentary to the make-up and theme.
10. A costume or clothing must be worn appropriate to and must compliment the theme and overall look.
11. Competitors must provide and present an A4 size sheet of their work with the following details.
  - Name
  - Salon name or Training school
  - Theme and inspiration behind the theme.
  - Make-up mediums and brand used.
  - Make up face chart of the colours and make-up used for the various different areas on the face.

## 3<sup>rd</sup> September

**Fantasy Category** - *Competitors have complete artistic freedom in this category to create a complete look that is beyond your wildest imagination.*

✂ **Student** - Competitors have 4 hours to complete their make-up.

✂ **Professional** - Competitors have 3 ½ hours to complete their make-up.

#### Rules & Regulations

**Theme:** Super Heroes

1. This category will take place on the 3<sup>rd</sup> of September.
2. Pre-judging criteria will apply for this category.
3. Make-up should cover the entire face and part of the body
4. Airbrush equipment may be used.

5. All professional make-up media will be allowed, as long as it is applied according to professional and proper application techniques, hygienically and safely, i.e. airbrushing, water colour, cream make-up, etc.
6. Pre-formed Prosthetics may be used and fitted to the head and neck only it should not comprise of more than 50% of the design and **may not** be pre-painted.
7. Bald caps, wigs and hairpieces may be used.
8. Headdresses may be used and worn but **MUST NOT** be shop-bought and should have been made by the competitor. This must be fitted in the competition time.
9. Costumes may be worn to compliment the overall theme and must be made by the competitor, but should not hide or cover the overall design.
10. Storyboard or explanation of the character chosen and materials used to accomplish the look.

**Body Painting Category** - *Competitors have to interpret and depict the set theme into a body painting.*

✂ **Student Category only** - Competitors have 4 hours to complete their make-up.

## Rules & Regulations

### Theme: Monsters & Aliens

1. This category will take place on the 3<sup>rd</sup> of September.
2. Pre-judging criteria will apply for this category as well so please ensure you read the Rules and Regulations properly and know what these criteria are, please see attached.
3. Contestants will have 3 ½ hours to complete the given task and make-up application.
4. Make-up should cover the entire face and at least three quarters of the entire body or the full body.
5. Airbrush equipment may be used to achieve the look and theme, please bring your own adaptors.
6. All professional make-up media will be allowed, as long as it is applied according to professional and proper application techniques, hygienically and safely, i.e. airbrushing, water colour, cream make-up, etc.
7. Pre-formed prosthetics may be used and should not comprise of more than 25% of the design and **may not** be pre-painted.
8. The make application must be carried through from top to toe to depict the entire chosen design and theme.
9. Bald caps may be used and painted over to achieve the desired look.
10. Head dresses may be used and worn but **MUST NOT** be shop-bought and should have been made by the competitor.
11. Body stockings may be worn to complement the overall theme, but should not hide or cover the overall design.
12. Competitors may paint over the body stocking or pieces of clothing.
13. Competitors must use discretion when working on their models, completely nude models will not be allowed.
14. Story board or explanation and interpretation of the chosen theme with the details below must be provided ;
  - Name
  - Contact details
  - Theme Name
  - Inspiration and interpretation of theme

- Explanation of how the look was achieved.
- Make-up and type mediums used to achieve the overall look.

***Failure to abide by the above competition Rules & Regulations will result in disqualification.***
